



COVID-19 VACCINATION AVAILABLE AT HEALTH DEPARTMENT CLINICS

GALLATIN, Tenn. – The Sumner County Health Department announced today that Friday, June 25 will be the last day of COVID-19 vaccine administration at the Volunteer State Community College campus.

Vaccines will be available at the Portland, Hendersonville, and Gallatin Clinics starting Monday, June 28 from 8:30 AM – 4:00 PM Monday thru Friday. Appointments are encouraged but not mandatory to receive the COVID-19 vaccine.

Staff will be available during these hours and will provide curbside service for individuals wishing to receive the vaccine. Upon arrival at clinic, please follow signs and directions provided.

Clinics will be closed on Monday, July 5 in observance of Independence Day. Contact your local health department for more information.
